Tom Fuller, a retired nature writer who lives in Belchertown, will present at the next Quabbin Art Association meeting on Thursday, April 19, 2018 at the Belchertown Town Hall, 2 Jabish Street, Belchertown, MA.

A lifelong angler and a writer, Tom has published more than 2,500 articles in fishing and outdoor magazines and authored four books. He is also the former New England editor of *Field & Stream* and the former Northeast regional columnist for *Outdoor Life* magazines. Tom is nationally recognized as an authority on fly-fishing.

Mr. Fuller has been a bird enthusiast since the 1960s. He started woodcarving in the 1980s, but his art was put on the back burner while employment was a priority. Now retired, he again took up serious bird carving about five years ago. He specializes in New England songbirds but also carves an occasional duck. He has won several awards for his amazing carvings.
